Psychotropic medications, for example, amitriptyline, fluoxetine, nortriptyline, paroxetine, venlafaxine, haloperidol, and risperidone/depression and antipsychotics	Variations in CYP450 alleles, including 2D6 and 2C19	Many tests for variants exist in the marketplace.
