

Clariant modifies SeqWright, 3/14

March 2014—Clariant Diagnostic Services, a GE Healthcare company, has modified its facility in Houston to support a full range of clinical diagnostic testing for cancer. The facility, which operates under the name SeqWright Genomic Services, is a CLIA-certified lab offering nucleic acid sequencing and genomics services. GE Healthcare acquired the laboratory in 2012.
