Seegene unveils molecular testing system

Sept. 29, 2021—<u>Seegene</u> unveiled its first fully automated PCR testing system, Starlet-AlOS, at the 2021 AACC annual meeting, Sept. 26–30, in Atlanta.

The system is composed of independent and detachable modules along with the company's proprietary SW architecture. It is designed with an extraction/liquid handler and PCR instrument that are integrated with an inhouse-developed robotic arm module. Seegene says laboratories can purchase the full package AlOS system or integrate their existing instruments on site if they already have Seegene's liquid handler and real-time PCR instrument.
