

SLAS expands global operations, 12/13

December 2013—The Society for Laboratory Automation and Screening, an international community of more than 15,000 scientists, engineers, researchers, technologists, and others from academic, government, and commercial laboratories, announced the opening of a European office in Brussels, Belgium. SLAS' European office becomes the society's third on three continents, joining operations in Shanghai, China, and its global headquarters in the United States.

Approximately 20 percent of SLAS' global membership is based in Europe. To better serve these constituents, SLAS will customize its products and services for its European members.

Short-term objectives for the SLAS European office include establishing a volunteer leadership team and building alliances with complementary, mission-driven organizations that also serve the scientific technology professional community.
