

## Third patent awarded for BioDot's multiple FISH tests, 6/15

**June 2015—The U.S. Patent and Trademark Office awarded a third U.S. patent** to BioDot for its FISHArray technology and methods. BioDot's patent family broadly covers technology and methods for performing multiple fluorescence in situ hybridization, immunohistochemistry, and cytogenetic tests on a single substrate, whether performed manually or through automated workstations, such as the company's CellWriter Workstation.

"FISH and karyotyping assays have historically been performed as a one assay, one slide paradigm. The FISHArray technology and methods show labs that huge economic benefits can be realized through miniaturization," said Tom Tisone, CEO of BioDot.
